**Grade 6 Trip** 

November 6-8, 2024

Dear School Committee Members,

The Grade Six teachers would like to offer Nature's Classroom for an twelfth year next fall. Nature's Classroom is a prominent education company that specializes in planning and executing educational programs. We have had a great experience with this program in the past, and feel that the educational, as well as the social/emotional, benefits that it has provided the students in the past is important and would benefit the incoming students next year as well.

The trip we would like to participate in is a three day, two night program located at Camp Cody in New Hampshire. It offers lodging and meals for the students and chaperones, as well as a curriculum during the day that is aligned to state standards and current curriculum. The programming allows the participants the opportunity to engage in many hands-on activities and unique experiences. Teachers will have the opportunity to work with the Nature's Classroom staff to choose curriculum that matches what is covered in the 6th grade, as well as including programming in the areas of team building and a low ropes course to help promote class unity as the students transition to middle school.

We would offer this program to all sixth grade students. The dates available for next year are November 6-8, 2024. Chaperones would include the grade six teachers and teaching assistants, as well as the program leaders and staff that would meet us on location and accompany us throughout the experience. Will will have at least 2 adults in each cabin of the same gender as the students.

The cost this year has increased by \$20 per student from last year. Nature's Classroom has raised their rate to \$365 per student. This covers meals, lodging, and programming during the stay. We recognize that this may be a hardship for many families, and have already been planning ways to fundraise to help provide scholarships. We will also need to cover the cost of the buses, but have not yet received the quote for this portion of the cost. We estimate the total cost per student will be \$500. In the event of a change in the operational costs for the buses we may need to adjust the final cost of the trip in the fall. The price represents operational costs, including an increase in fuel costs, food costs, and personnel cost.
