4. Literacy Planning Committee Update

Dr. Clifford presented to the school committee members an update from the Literacy Planning Committee. During her presentation Dr. Clifford highlighted several of the goals that the Literacy Committee has focused on and will continue to improve upon in the coming school year. Dr. Clifford stated that this is a three-year plan with many of the items already in progress. Communication with families is a key component; with a heavy emphasis on improving reading and writing for all students

- 5. Superintendent Evaluation

Mr. Brosgol went through the school committee's written responses of the evaluation of superintendent Conrad. Mr. Brosgol reviewed the entire 12-page document of the committee's responses to question asked regarding to Mr. Conrad's performance as Superintendent of Bedford Public School District during the 2020-2021 school year.

6. Superintendent's Report

Mr. Conrad informed the committee that he would provide them under separate cover a copy of the Entry Findings that he had received prior to the meeting. Also Mr. Conrad gave the reasoning for the half day on Tuesday as necessary to help cool down the buildings due to the extreme heat and humidity and that Wednesday would be a regular ¾ day for all students. Eight portable air conditioners were acquired through the facilities department for the Lane School. DESE 2021/2022 school year guidance will not require that masks be worn. However, students and staff participating in summer programs this year will have to continue to abide by the current protocols and wear masks. Cafeteria's will be back in use in the fall, MERF 15 filters will remain, HVAC will continue to run at high levels, HEPA filtration will remain in place at all buildings. Hand sanitizing stations, wipes and other PPE will be available at all schools. The play "You're a good man Charlie Brown" will take place on Friday and Saturday. Summer school update by school was as followed: grades K-2-88% of families said yes to summer school invite, at Lane 150 students were invited and half accepted. At JGMS 124 students were invited to summer school and only 20 accepted. BHS invited 64 students and only seven students accepted. Students attending summer school have been connected to town activities. All summer school staff have been hired. Lastly, Officer Wardwell is retiring at the end of this school year and Officer Hunt will take his place as the school resource officer.
