## 3. Bedford METCO History

METCO Director, Akil Mondesir shared a PowerPoint presentation on the Bedford/METCO relationship that is approaching its 50<sup>th</sup> year of collaboration. The presentation showed the Bedford/METCO connection through news clippings, music and testimonials from past alumni. Some of whom returned to Bedford to teach or support the district in many ways. Mr. Mondesir spoke about his own experiences with the METCO program as a student, then as an employee and now as a parent. The presentation showed the many changes that have taken place since 1974 and it lead to a conversation about what is happening now and what the program/partnership might look like in the coming years.

### 5. LABB-Review of collective agreement-1st Read

Mr. Conrad presented to the School Committee the proposed changes to the LABBB agreement that are legally necessary to allow Waltham Public Schools to join. Mr. Conrad explained that with the addition of Waltham Public School the vocational component that is not currently available to our

students would become available with this addition. Mr. Conrad also stated that new disillusion language was added to this new agreement as to not have a repeat of what happened a year ago when Acton Public School withdrew from the collaborative group. All districts in the agreement must be within close proximity to one another. It took five months to get to this new agreement and it will go into effect on July 1, 2023. A vote by School Committee members will be needed at a future meeting to accept the proposed changes presented this evening.

# 6. Superintendent Report

Mr. Conrad shared the following during his Superintendent's report to the School Committee. As everyone is aware today was a snow day. Tomorrow we will resume our regular school schedule. Mr. Conrad wanted to remind the 1<sup>st</sup> grade students that today was Pi day. Just like in the book, they had read with him. Chicago-Teen edition will be performing this week at BHS. Stem Night will be held on Thursday night at Davis. JGMS will hold its Tenacity Challenge this weekend. Student art show will be happening until April 1, 2023 at Lexart. Destination Imagination was held last weekend. We had 28 DECA representatives this year and from that we had 7 state winners and 3 finalist.
