Pearl Harbor Day

On Tuesday we commemorated Pearl Harbor Day. The day is a remembrance of the surprise attack by Japanese forces on Sunday, December 7, 1941, of the United States naval base at Pearl Harbor near Honolulu, Hawaii. The attack occurred just before 8 a.m. on that Sunday morning. Hundreds of Japanese fighter planes descended on the base, where they managed to destroy or damage nearly 20 American naval vessels, including eight battleships, and over 300 airplanes. More than 2,400 Americans died in the attack, including civilians, and another 1,000 people were wounded. The day after the assault, President Franklin D. Roosevelt asked Congress to declare war on Japan. COVID-19 Testing Programs

We continued with COVID safety checks this week for grades Pre-K to 12. This week we completed 333 tests at Davis, 383 tests at Lane, 220 tests at JGMS, and 114 tests at BHS. The results of the tests at Davis, JGMS and BHS were negative. This week there were 2 positive pools at Lane School which resulted in 2 positive cases. All positive cases and close contacts have been notified.

We will continue testing next week, the week of December 13th. Please note, we will not be testing the week of December 20th. We can only run the pooled testing program when the school is able to complete the entire process from the initial period pooled test through completion of all needed follow-up tests/tracing. We will resume weekly testing after the December break.

We continue to encourage everyone to sign up for the COVID-19 safety tests as a means of keeping the community safe.
