The event will feature guest speaker The Reverend Willie Bodrick, senior pastor of the historic Twelfth Baptist Church in Roxbury, Massachusetts (https://tbcboston.org/the-pastor). Bodrick, a graduate of Harvard Divinity School and Northeastern University School of Law, leads the church where Dr. King preached and worshiped while pursuing his theology degree at Boston University 70 years ago.
