Letter from DPH

Just prior to vacation we received a letter from the Department of Public Health and the Massachusetts chapter of the American Academy of Pediatrics and the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education DESE which was developed for parents and guardians. This letter was finalized on December 21, 2022, and shared with school leaders on Thursday, December 22, 2022, for distribution just after vacation. The letter discussed how the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) expanded the use of updated (bivalent) COVID-19 vaccines for children ages 6 months through 5 years. The CD approved this expansion on December 9, 2022. The letter is posted on the DESE website and can be accessed here. The letter is available in English, Arabic, Chinese, Haitian Creole, Spanish, and Vietnamese.

The MA Behavioral Health Help Line (BHHL) Launches

The Massachusetts Department of Mental Health launched the new Massachusetts Behavioral Health Help Line on January 3, 2023. The Help Line is available 24/7 to provide assistance across the state and in more than 200 languages to help anyone in need of mental health services connect with a provider. For individuals who are deaf or hard of hearing contact MassRelay at 711 to be connected to The Help Line. The BHHL is free and available to all Massachusetts residents.

BPS Textile Collection

We are happy to report that the Bedford Public Schools now has Textile Collection Bins at all four schools. We recently added bins to Davis and JGMS. This is a fundraiser for our schools. The money received from collecting the textiles is then given to each school's administration to be used for various student oriented programs such as, green teams, and scholarships for school trips and events. To date we have collected over 46,000 tons of clothing! Parents and residents are encouraged to contribute to this program which benefits our school programs and the environment by keeping these clothes out of the waste stream.

Budget Update

The School Committee will do a line-item review of the Superintendent's FY24 Budget on Tuesday, January 17, 2023 and has scheduled a public hearing and final vote on Tuesday, January 24, 2023, with a presentation to the Bedford Finance Committee on Thursday, February 9, 20223.
