USDA extends to June 2021

The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) announced the extension of universal free meals to continue to be available to all children and teens throughout the entire School Year 2020-2021. This will allow us to leverage the Seamless Summer Option (SSO) and Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) to provide meals at no cost through June 30, 2021.

COVID-19

This week has seen a decrease in COVID-19 cases here in town and in the schools. As a community we moved back to green from yellow (10/14/20). However, many local communities in our area have gone in the other direction. Please continue your increased vigilance when it comes to maintaining social distance, wearing a mask, and washing/sanitizing our hands.

Impact Aid Survey (PL 874)

This law entitles Bedford to submit a Federal Impact Aid application, however, it is dependent on our collecting data from families that are <u>Armed Forces personnel</u> and/or <u>parents/guardians who work on federal property</u>. All Armed Forces personnel are eligible regardless of where they are stationed including overseas deployment as long as the family residence is in Bedford or on Hanscom Air Force Base. For your convenience we have set up a dedicated website which can be accessed at <u>Federal Aid Impact Survey PL874</u>.

<u>Technology</u>

I am pleased to tell you that you will be receiving an email very soon from the technology department that will outline our deployment of Lightspeed Relay. We have recently purchased the Lightspeed Relay system for all of our devices. The system will allow us to provide protections on all school-issued devices regardless of what network the device is connected to when devices are outside of our school buildings. We researched and tested several options and found Lightspeed Relay to be the best solution for a safe online experience while meeting the regulations and approval of the TEC Alliance.
