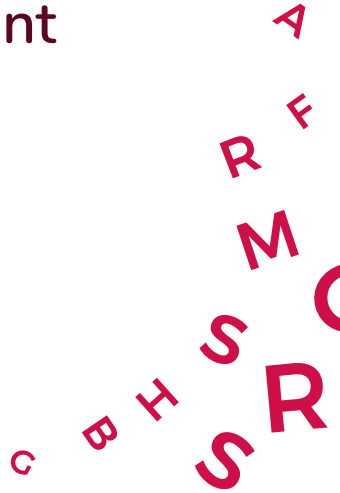
Closing Out Plans
