Please sign up for Symptomatic testing, Routine COVID safety checks, and our "Test and Stay" Protocol HERE

We are working with the state's testing vendor CIC and will implement pooled testing in our schools as soon as possible. We will begin as soon as our supplies arrive and our on-site scheduling has been finalized with CIC Health. We are requesting that everyone who is not vaccinated to sign up for weekly COVID-19 testing in order to help keep our schools open and safe.

We urge everyone to sign up for the testing program as an additional protective measure. Keep in mind that <u>Test and Stay</u> allows non-symptomatic close contacts to come to school, get tested and if negative go to class. If a child tests positive they are sent home. <u>Symptomatic testing</u> is used when a student starts to have symptoms of COVID-19 at school; students should not come to school if they are feeling sick while at home. <u>Routine COVID-19 safety checks</u> (previously called Pooled testing) allows students and staff to be tested on a regular basis. This year each of us will be providing two samples so that in the case of a positive pool each individual can be tested in the lab and the positive COVID-19 case easily identified. The samples will be taken via nasal swab at school. To date 15% of BHS, 25% of JGMS, 45% of Lane, and 44 % of Davis students have signed up for the testing program.

<u>Please keep in mind that to date our test and stay program has not revealed any in-school transmission.</u>

Vaccination Rate Update

To date 71% of students who are eligible for vaccination (12 years or older) at JGMS and 72% of students are vaccinated. Please keep in mind that the Bedford Department of Health and Human Services will be offering a vaccination clinic tomorrow as part of Bedford Day. September 11, 2001

Last Saturday I was able to join Hanscom Air Force Base Commander Colonel Stephens, Chief Master Sergeant Hebb and their families aboard the USS Constitution along with 12 of the nation's 67 living Medal of Honor recipients. The Constitution cruised from her berth in Charlestown to Castle Island and back. The cruise included a reenactment of Old Ironsides's War of 1812 battle with HMS Guerriere, a 21-gun salute at Castle Island, a flyover by the Massachusetts Air National Guard's 104th Fighter Wing with F-15E Strike Eagles, as well as a

17-gun salute as the Constitution passed U.S. Coast Guard Base Boston, the former site of Edmund Hartt's Shipyard, where the USS Constitution was built and launched on Oct. 21, 1797. All of this was overseen by USS Constitution's 76th Commanding Officer Commander John Benda, Executive Officer Andrew Broyles, and Command Senior Chief Angela Collins. The highlight of the day was the unexpected opportunity afforded to activity duty military personnel who were able to climb the Constitution's riggings. It was a thrill to see both Colonel Stephens and Chief Master Sergeant Hebb make the climb. Thank you to Ms. Erin Crowley for this opportunity.
