#### Veterans Day Reminder

Please note that next Thursday, November 11, 2021, is Veterans Day. It is a Federal holiday and therefore the schools will be closed and no classes will occur. Veterans Day marks the armistice that ended World War I on November 11, 1918. The armistice went into effect on the eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the eleventh month. For that reason, November 11, 1918, is generally regarded as the end of "the war to end all wars." In November 1919, President Wilson proclaimed November 11 as the first commemoration of Armistice Day with the following words: "To us in America, the reflections of Armistice Day will be filled with solemn pride in the heroism of those who died in the country's service and with gratitude for the victory, both because of the thing from which it has freed us and because of the opportunity it has given America to show her sympathy with peace and justice in the councils of the nations..." Since that time our nation has used this day as a day of reflection for all who have made the ultimate sacrifice for our country. #### COVID-19 Testing Programs

We continued with COVID safety checks this week for grades Pre-K to 12. This week we completed 319 tests at Davis, 219 tests at JGMS and 115 tests at BHS.. The results of the tests to date have all been negative. We will be testing at all schools next week., JGMS on Monday, Lane on Tuesday, BHS and Davis on Wednesday. We continue to encourage everyone to sign up for the COVID-19 safety tests as a means of keeping the community safe.
