Hello Bedford School Community,

Today, in a rare occurrence I am sending TWO letters. My usual Friday letter (this one) and a second to let you know that during the week of January 3, 2022, the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education's Office of Public School Monitoring (PSM) will conduct a Tiered Focused Monitoring Review of Bedford Public Schools. The Office of Public School Monitoring visits each district and charter school every three years to monitor compliance with federal and state special education and civil rights regulations. This second letter is required by DESE.

COVID-19 Testing Programs

We continued with COVID safety checks this week for grades Pre-K to 12. This week we completed 335 tests at Davis, 380 tests at Lane, 202 tests at JGMS, and 122 tests at BHS. The results of the tests at Davis, Lane, and JGMS were negative. This week there was one positive pool at BHS, and that individual who was part of the positive pool has been notified and contact tracing completed.

Please note, we will not be testing during the short week of Thanksgiving (November 22nd, 23rd, 24th). We can only run the pooled testing program when the school is able to complete the entire process from the initial period pooled test through completion of all needed follow-up tests/tracing. We will be testing next week and will test all schools the week following Thanksgiving break. We continue to encourage everyone to sign up for the COVID-19 safety tests as a means of keeping the community safe.
