
Military Impact Aid Survey - due by October 21.

As we do each October, we are asking for parent/guardian cooperation in filling out a survey form to meet the requirements of Public Law 874. Under the provisions of Public Law 874, Bedford Public Schools must conduct an annual Military Impact Aid Survey. The Town of Bedford receives a substantial sum of money under this provision, which lowers the cost of education to the taxpayers and brings supplemental resources to Bedford that benefit all of our students. Help us identify all federally connected students whose families are Active Duty Military, live on Hanscom AFB, work on federal facilities (including Hanscom AFB, Bedford VA, Boston VA, Lincoln Public School on HAFB, Lincoln Labs, Mitre) or are Active Duty Military! All families will receive a unique survey for each student via a DocuSign email on Monday October 2, 2023.

My life was in danger trying to help children in Guatemala. I had to choose exile. A refugee journalist and humanitarian makes a new home in Boston with her family. By Stef Arreaga Updated September 15, 2023, 7:54 a.m.



We landed at Logan Airport on a cold night in late November 2021. A diminutive Vietnamese man waited for us at baggage claim, smiling and holding out jackets, hats, and gloves. Out on the street, the winter cold nipped our faces. I remember

the looks my three children gave me - a mix of astonishment, fear, and uncertainty.

On Interstate 93 headed to Dorchester, we looked out the back window at the twinkling lights of downtown, welcoming us to our new lives. From that moment, we couldn't hear the word "Guatemala" without a lump in our throats, without missing every corner and taste of our country and more than anything, our family there.
