

- Attend Hanscom meetings with Assistant Principal




Applications for the Class of 2008

- 1095 transcripts, or 7 applications per student who applied, were processed
- 51% of applications accepted, 24% denied, 9% waitlisted, 16% withdrawn
- 65 students, or 30% applied Early Action or Early Decision
