

PERSONAL SAFETY

LESSON TWO: STRANGER MANAGEMENT ASSERTIVENESS SKILLS

GRADE LEVEL: 2nd Grade

OVERVIEW: This lesson defines the word "stranger." It will further allow students to recognize and assess unsafe situations and identify the appropriate response and actions to take in potentially unsafe or dangerous situations. The students will strengthen their assertiveness skills and understand the personal safety steps.

GOALS AND OBJECTIVES: Identify different types of strangers and define acceptable interactions with each type. Strengthen the child's assertive skills and develop an understanding of different ways to say "NO." Learning assertive skills and saying "NO" in an assertive manner.

At the completion of this lesson students will demonstrate the ability to:

- Identify and define the word "stranger."
- Recognize the need to seek help from strangers and determine the best person to approach.
- Say "NO" to unsafe requests.
- Say the following safety steps with assertiveness: **YELL "NO," GO and TELL.**
