5. 2024-2027 Student Opportunity Act Plan- 1st read & Vote

Superintendent Chuang briefly went over with School Committee members the Student Opportunity Act Plan document. The Student Opportunity Act (SOA) was established by DESE in 2019, with a focus on providing funding to districts serving

students with the greatest needs. Every district must set clear targets for improving disparities in achievement among student groups and develop a three-year plan to implement evidence-based strategies to meet their targets. The first set of three-year plans were submitted during COVID. The second round of three-year plans is due to DESE on April 1, 2024. More details about Bedford's 2024-2027 plans will be shared at our next meeting. Your approval is required by DESE, prior to formal submission.

Our first SOA plan, this next SOA plan will focus on literacy. The plan focuses on the shift we are making in our approach to literacy instruction as discussed throughout the fall and winter.
