We are deeply committed to achieving educational equity for all of our students, with a particular emphasis on closing racially based opportunity gaps. Ongoing professional development in antiracism practices and culturally responsive teaching, our district-wide Equity and Diversity Committee, our Interracial Parent Advisory Committee, our affinity groups, our Tenacity Challenge (<u>www.tenacitychallenge.com</u>) and Calculus Projects all contribute to closing gaps, to creating safe spaces for all of our students to take intellectual risks, and to building bridges across racial differences. Improving upon this work continues to be one of our core missions.
