Bedford High School Dance Contract

This contract hereby states the rules and consequences that must be followed at all school-sponsored events which are held on and off campus. All school rules governing behavior as detailed in the Student Handbook apply to dances and school-sponsored events. By signing your name to the agreement, you agree to the following rules, and it is understood that if you do not adhere to the outlined expectations you may be subject to the consequences listed below. In addition, students must adhere to any specific rules for a particular dance. Refusal to comply with requests of administrators or staff members will be considered insubordination and could result in a suspension in accordance with the Student Handbook.

RULES	CONSEQUENCES
Consumption of alcohol or any controlled substance is prohibited before or during the dance. Upon admission at school dances, proms and other school-sponsored events on or off school property, every student shall be subject to the following: (Upon entrance) a search of the students' jackets, pocketbooks, athletic bags or backpacks. (Upon entrance) confiscation of water bottles or other beverage container. In addition, a student shall be subject to an Alco-Blow test at school or a school sponsored event whether on or off school property. Results from a breath alcohol test may be used as a component for determination of school-based disciplinary consequences.	 → Parent notification and removal from the dance. → Exclusion from (a minimum of one dance) with carryover to the next year (including proms). → Suspension from sports and extra-curricular activities in accordance with MIAA guidelines articulated in the student handbook. → Suspension will apply to current or "next season" of participation. → Loss of leadership roles in school activities and teams. → Suspension from school per the Student Handbook. → Police notification.
If students dance, then he/she will dance in a style that will not offend others. Students must remain upright at all times when dancing.	→ Removal from dance and exclusion from a minimum of one dance (including proms).
Once a student leaves the dance, he or she may not return.	→ No re-admittance for any reason.
Students must remain within the physical boundaries of the dance area.	→ Removal from the dance.
Students are expected to wear the appropriate attire for the occasion.	→ Denied admission.
Entrance to the dance will be closed at the halfway point after the stated beginning time.	→ Denied admission.
Dances are for Bedford High School students. Visitors may be approved to attend proms and the semi-formal only after completing the necessary paperwork prior to purchasing a ticket.	→ Removal of both non-Bedford High School student and Bedford High School host from dance.
Students must attend school the day of the dance or they will not be admitted. For a weekend event, students must attend school on the most recent school day. BHS administration must approve any exceptions to the rule.	→ Denied admission.

Student understands that if found in violation of any school rules, no refunds will be authorized for any tickets or other expenses that may have incurred for said or future events. No student will be allowed to buy a ticket without signing the parent/guardian and student sign-off agreement.
